

Research Interviewees: Looking for Korean Students from Latin America

Hola! My name is Jin Suk Bae, and I am a research professor at the Sogang Institute of American Studies (SIAS) at Sogang University in Seoul. I am conducting research on ethnic Korean university students who were born in or have returned from Latin America. I am desperately looking for suitable research interviewees.

My study aims to enhance our understanding of the experiences of Korean students who came from Latin America and to suggest effective policy measures to better support educational opportunities for them. Interviewees' personal experiences and opinions will enable me to successfully complete this research project.

The interviews will be conducted in either English or Korean, and the eligibility for qualifying as an interviewee are as follows:

- 1) You must be Korean and have lived in a Latin American country **for longer than two years.**
- 2) You must currently be enrolled in an **undergraduate** or **graduate** program in a university located in Korea.

I have a longstanding, deep interest in overseas Koreans and have written a doctoral dissertation on the resettlement processes of Korean immigrants from Latin America residing in the New York area. During my fieldwork in New York City, I was also actively involved in volunteer work at a number of immigrant support organizations.

Through your participation, you will contribute your knowledge and experiences to deepening our understanding of Koreans in and from Latin America.
